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**2018 Simulation Academy Novice Research Grant - \$5,000**

**“How to WIN at Resuscitation – A New Model for Intra-Resuscitation Recaps”**

Our study has two goals. First, we will evaluate a novel team training tool, the WIN tool, which is aimed at increasing the frequency and efficiency of intra-resuscitation team recaps. We will evaluate the tool’s effect on clinical effectiveness, situation awareness, and frequency of recaps. Secondly, we wish to determine if there is a difference in situation awareness depending on the role an individual has within a resuscitation team, and if differences change with the use of the WIN tool.

We hypothesize that our tool will increase team recap behavior, improve situation awareness, and improve clinical effectiveness compared to the usual methods arm. We further hypothesize that situation awareness will be highest in the team leader role, and any physician who performs a procedure will have a lower situation awareness.
